## Yearling Lunge Line and Yearling led Trail

The Lunge Line class is judged partly on conformation, and the yearling will require to be lunged on a line which may not exceed 9.15 metres. You will have 1.5 minutes to present your horse at a walk, trot & canter.

The led Trail: your horse may be required to walk over poles, back, and go sideways, in a pattern set by the judge.

This information is meant to help you know what is expected of you in the classes. Full details will be available on the website and in the next magazine.

**TERMS & CONDITIONS**

**This show will award double points in all points approved classes.**

- Dogs must be on a lead at all times. Any dog found running loose will be impounded.
- All horses must be yarded at night in their allocated yards.
- ESNZ approved steel portable pens may be used during daytime for mares, geldings, and stallions.
- Horses tied to trucks or floats must be under supervision.
- *Manure and waste hay must be put in the skip provided.*
- All stallions must be supervised when not in their yards or pens.
- All stallions 2 years and over must be identified with a red S on halter or bridle at all times.
- **No electric fence pens for horses at any time, loose or tied.**
- Youth may not ride or be in control of a stallion at any time during the show.  
(Exceptions may be made at council's discretion)
- **Any person under the influence of drink or drugs may be asked to leave the show area.**
- **All owners and competitors must be financial members of ApHANZ Inc.**  
(A non-member may only show a horse in hand as long as the horse's owner is on the grounds and they have obtained a day membership.)
- **All competitors must produce horse registration papers on demand. Failure to produce same will result in disqualification. The show committee reserves the right to inspect any horse's registration papers and brands.**
- **This is a closed breed show. All foals/yearlings to be shown must be progeny recorded and all horses two years old or over must be permanently registered before applying for entry.**
- **Random drug testing may be carried out at this show as per ESNZ rules.**
- As this show is a closed breed show, false tails or additional colour of any kind will not be allowed on any day during this show. Manes may be banded on Halter and Western Performance days and plaited on English day.
- The ApHANZ Inc and co-sponsoring organisations, if any, will not be responsible for any accident that may occur to or be caused by any horse at the show, or for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed or in any way damaged.
- Halter classes will be run under the ApHANZ Inc breed halter rules.  
Western performance classes will be run under the NZWRF rules.  
English performance classes will be run under the ESNZ rules. Points received are for ApHANZ only. The English classes are not registered ESNZ classes. Points gained do not count for any ESNZ class.
- **Youth may nominate one horse only** for each different sector to be counted for High Points Awards:  
i.e. Western Performance, Games & English
- Date of arrival must be stated on entry form for the arrangement of facilities.
- English competitors will have a gear safety check before the jumping events.
- All riders must wear ESNZ approved hard hats in all speed events.
- All refunds less 20% admin. Vet or doctor's certificate required within seven days of the event.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to alter or amend this schedule depending on entry numbers and conditions.
- Horses registered with the NZWRF must enter using their registered number, which must be used in every event.
- Horses without NZWRF numbers will be allocated an ApHANZ number. A \$2 refundable deposit must be paid for each number with your entries.
- **Competitors please note – All classes entered on a horse must be on the same form regardless of handler/rider.**
- Competitors with stallions & wet mares get first preference of yards near club house.
